Germany declared war on Russia and invaded Luxembourg

Tuesday August 4, 1914

Germany declared war on Belgium

Great Britain declared war on Germany

Fr Maxim Sandovich (husband, son of Timko Sandovich, arrested in early 1912 on espionage charges; acquitted in Lviv on June 6, 1914; **UPDATE**: arrested for suspected Russian sympathies, pregnant wife also arrested)

Timko Sandovich (father of Fr Maxim Sandovich, arrested)
