Fr Franciszek Grabowski (aged 45, banished by the White [anti-Communist] government to Malinchevsky, outside Tomsk for failing to support the collaboration of Polish soldiers with the Whites)

Russia: Volokolamsk

Fr Nikolay Ivanovich Tsvetkov (aged 39, arrested by the Bolsheviks, sentenced to forced labor, cleaned toilets and operated a horse-drawn septic wagon)
