Sunday March 3, 1918



Iran: Salmas

Patriarch Shimun XXI Benyamin (aged 30, **assassinated** along with 150 of his bodyguards by Ottoman forces while under a flag of truce during the Assyrian Genocide)

Fr Mikhail Mikhailovich Lisitsin (aged 55, husband, arrested by the Bolsheviks, tortured for three days)

Fr Mikhail Mikhailovich Lisitsin (aged 55, husband, arrested by the Bolsheviks on [March 7, 1918](#), tortured for three days; **UPDATE**: **killed**, the Bolsheviks forbade his burial but his widow was able to purchase his body for burial)

Mar Shimun XXI Paulos (aged 37, brother of Patriarch Shimun XXI Benyamin, succeeded his brother as Patriarch after his assassination)

Russia: Novgorod

Metropolitan Andrey Sheptytsky OSBM (aged 52, brother of Archimandrite Klymentiy Sheptytsky, arrested by invading Russian troops in [Lviv](#) in [September 1914](#), sent to Russia; **UPDATE**: freed, returned to Lviv, later put under house arrest by invading Poles)
