Sunday June 16, 1918



Russia: Pokrovskoe village, Yarkovsky District, Tyumen Oblast

Bishop Hermogenes aka Georgiy Yefremovich Dolganyov (aged 60, had expelled Joseph Dzhugashvili [aka Joseph Stalin] from the seminary in 1899, exiled without trial to a monastery by the Tsar in 1911 after he physically assaulted Grigori Rasputin; **UPDATE: drowned** by the Bolsheviks in the Tura River)

Catholicos-Patriarch Kyrion II aka Giorgi Sadzaglishvili (aged 62, widower, **murdered** by persons unknown)

Ukraine: Nizhne-Bogdanovka, outside Luhansk

Fr Piotr Emelianov (aged 34, converted from the Russian Orthodox Church to the Russian Catholic Church, as a result suffered frequent attacks and beatings along with his parishioners, later arrested in 1918 in succession by the Whites, Germans, Ukrainians, and Bolsheviks)
