Ukraine: Nizhne-Bogdanovka, outside Luhansk

Fr Piotr Emelianov (aged 35, converted from the Russian Orthodox Church to the Russian Catholic Church on [June 29, 1918](#), as a result suffered frequent attacks and beatings along with his parishioners, later arrested in [1918](#) in succession by the Whites, Germans, Ukrainians, and Bolsheviks; released by the Bolsheviks on [December 27, 1918](#); **UPDATE:** arrested again by the Whites)
