### China: Henan

Fr Pasquale Angelico Melotto OFM (aged 59, Italian citizen, abducted by bandits for ransom, beaten, **killed**)

### Ukraine

Fr Wladyslaw Dworzecki (aged 49, sentenced to death on [September 2, 1922](#) as an 'incorrigible enemy of the Soviet regime', commuted to 2 years' imprisonment; **UPDATE**: granted early release, returned to Kamyanets-Podilsky, arrested and released several more times through 1929)

### Poland: Poznan

Metropolitan Andrey Sheptytsky OSBM (aged 58, brother of Archimandrite Klymentiy Sheptytsky, arrested by invading Russian troops in [Lviv](#) in [September 1914](#), sent to Russia; freed in [March 1918](#), returned to [Lviv](#), later put under house arrest by invading Poles; freed from house arrest in [1920](#) after Vatican intervention; **UPDATE**: arrested for his comments regarding oppression of the Ukrainian minority, freed after three months)
