### USSR

Fr Aleksander Kuczynski (aged 63, arrested in [Novohrad-Volynskiy, Ukraine](#), in 1923, sent into internal exile for 3 years; **UPDATE**: released from exile)

### Russia: Karamin, Taurida province, Crimea

Freidrich Faut (aged 28, husband, father of five, arrested on anti-revolutionary conspiracy charges, later released)

### Russia: Leningrad

Maria Awglo (aged 65, arrested, sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp)

Fr Stanislaw Baranowski (aged 38, arrested and deported to Poland, later served in Vilnius, Lithuania, fate unknown)

### Russia: Orel Prison

Siergiej Karpinski (former seminarian, arrested in [Petrograd](#) in [November 1923](#); sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment on [May 19, 1924](#), sent to [Orel Prison](#); **UPDATE**: transferred to Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp, worked in a sawmill)

### Russia: Simferopol

Fr Alexander Frison (aged 50, investigated in 1923, spent 6 months in jail; **UPDATE**: arrested and tried, released on appeal, case closed)

### Ukraine: Kiev

Mikhail Ivasechko (aged 43, former miner, cabinetmaker, arrested for distributing counter-revolutionary aka religious pamphlets, given a suspended sentence)

Stanislawa Lepesowecka (aged 37, artist, factory worker, arrested, released)

**Ukraine: Odessa**

Fr Paul Asheberg (aged 30, sent into internal exile)

**Ukraine: Zhytomyr**

Fr Arkady Ostalsky (aged 37, arrested in the [spring of 1922](#) for resisting the seizure of church property, sentenced to death, said "I thank God for everything. For me, death is an acquisition", sentence commuted to 5 years' imprisonment; **UPDATE**: granted early release)
