## Sunday February 1, 1925



#### Russia: Lefortovo Prison, Moscow

Fr Stanislaw Ejsmont (aged 38, went into hiding during an April 1920 investigation in Petrograd, not arrested; refused to turn church valuables over to the Petrograd government on July 27, 1922; arrested in Moscow on March 10, 1923 on counter-revolutionary charges; sentenced on March 26, 1923 to 10 years' imprisonment; **UPDATE**: released, sent to Poland in a prisoner exchange)

# Russia: Sokolnicheskaya Prison

Fr Pawel Chodniewicz (aged 44, arrested on counter-revolutionary charges on March 10, 1923; convicted on March 26, 1923, sentence to 10 years' imprisonment; **UPDATE**: released, sent to Poland in a prisoner exchange)

#### **Russia: Leningrad**

Fr Michal Dmowski (aged 51, arrested on anti-Soviet charges on May 9, 1922; released on June 2, 1922, charges deemed 'unprovable'; **UPDATE**: arrested on espionage and counter-revolutionary charges)
