Russia: Leningrad

Fr Michal Dmowski (aged 52, arrested on espionage and counter-revolutionary charges on [February 17, 1925](#); sentenced to death on [June 22, 1925](#); **UPDATE**: released after an international outcry, sent to Poland)

Belarus: Mogilev

Fr Jozef Bielogolowy (aged 43, sentenced on [February 18, 1922](#) on espionage charges to 5 years' in a concentration camp, sentence reduced to one year at the end of 1922; **UPDATE**: arrested on espionage and counter-revolutionary charges, refused to sign the confession saying "holding me in custody has an undesirable impact on the faithful within the country and gives a trump card to the anti-Soviet bloc abroad")
