Russia: Moscow

Fr Leonid Fedorov (aged 46, arrested in Petrograd on February 23, 1923, charged with 'resisting the authorities in the seizure of church valuables, catechizing minors, foreign contacts, and counter-revolutionary propaganda'; convicted in Moscow on March 26, 1923, sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment, sent to Lefortovo and Sokolnicheskaya prisons; **UPDATE**: released early after foreign protests, sent on internal exile, settled in Kaluga)

Archbishop Hilarion aka Vladimir Alexeyevich Troitsky (aged 40, arrested on November 15, 1923; sentenced to a labor camp on December 7, 1923, sent to Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp; transferred to Yaroslavl Prison in July 1925; **UPDATE**: transferred back to Solovetsky)
