Friday November 18, 1927



Russia: Moscow

Fr Julian Cimaszkiewicz (aged 37, arrested on [June 23, 1927](#) on charges of 'anti-Soviet agitation and teaching religion to under-age children and minors'; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 8 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp)

Mexico: Teocaltitlan

Fr Pedro Ramirez Esqueda (pulled from his prison cell, told children as he was led away to be sure to learn their catechism, **shot dead**)

Wednesday November 23, 1927



Mexico: Mexico City

Humberto Pro (brother of Fr Miguel Agustin Pro SJ and Roberto Pro, **shot dead** by a firing squad without trial)

Fr Jose Ramon Miguel Agustín Pro Juarez SJ (aged 36, brother of Humberto Pro and Roberto Pro, **shot dead** by a firing squad without trial, his last words were "May God have mercy on you! May God bless you! Lord, Thou knowest that I am innocent! With all my heart I forgive my enemies!...Long live Christ the King!")

Miguel Pro Sr (received the bodies of his sons Fr Miguel Agustin Pro SJ and Humberto Pro into his home for the wake, ordered people to not mourn, later led a funeral procession of between 10,000 and 30,000 persons in defiance of a presidential order)

Roberto Pro (brother of Fr Miguel Agustin Pro SJ and Humberto Pro, released from prison)
