### **Russia: Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp**

Fr Jozef Jozwik (aged 56, arrested in [Moscow](#) on [August 6, 1928](#), charged with espionage based on recorded Mass intentions; sentenced in [April 1929](#) to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: arrived at Solovetsky)

Zygmunt Lepsowewcki (aged 51, office worker, arrested in [Kiev, Ukraine](#) on [February 16, 1929](#), and sent into 3 years' internal exile to Siberia; **UPDATE:** arrested)

**Russia: Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp**

Fr Wiktor Kryweczyk (aged 31, arrested in Brusyliv, [Ukraine](#) in [May 1926](#), sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE:** sent into 3 years' internal exile to Irkutsk)
