Fr Johannes Furcht (aged 39, arrested on [October 23, 1928](#) in [Selz](#) on anti-Soviet agitation charges; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp)

Fr Jozef Kowalski (aged 31, secretly ordained in [Leningrad](#) on [December 4, 1928](#); arrested in [Fastiv, Ukraine](#) on [May 29, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: during interrogation said “As a believer, I was dissatisfied with the policy of anti-religious propaganda of the Soviet regime, which forbade the opening of theological seminaries”)

Russia: Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp

Fr Franciszek Bujalski (aged 38, arrested in [Skvir, Bila Tserkva region, Ukraine](#) on [April 12, 1927](#); sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on [January 10, 1928](#); **UPDATE**: transferred to Anzer Island)

Fr Jozef Jozwik (aged 56, arrested in [Moscow](#) on [August 6, 1928](#), charged with espionage based on recorded Mass intentions; sentenced in [April 1929](#) to 10 years' imprisonment in a

labor camp; arrived at [Solovetsky](#) on [May 22, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: transferred to Anzer Island, worked as a lumberjack)

Fr Pawel Chomicz (aged 35, arrested in [Leningrad](#) on [December 3, 1926](#), charged with counter-revolutionary activities; sentenced on [June 27, 1927](#) to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; arrived at [Solovetsky](#) on [July 3, 1927](#); **UPDATE**: transferred to Anzer Island)

Fr Piotr Emelianov (aged 45, arrested in [Nizhne-Bogdanovka, Ukraine](#) on [January 27, 1927](#); sentenced in [Luhansk, Ukraine](#) on [September 12, 1927](#) to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: transferred to Anzer Island, took care of the mortally ill Fr Felix Lubczynski)
