China: Nanfeng, Fuzhou, Jiangxi

Fr Timothy Leonard SSC (aged 36, Irish citizen, **hacked to death** by Communist guerrillas after they invaded the church, interrupted Mass and trampled on consecrated hosts)

Fr Franciszek Andruszewicz (aged 49, arrested)

Fr Jan Lewinski (aged 58, arrested on [May 5, 1922](#) for concealing church valuables, sentenced to four months incarceration and forced labor; **UPDATE**: arrested, released soon after)

Russia: Butyrka Prison, Moscow

Fr Franciszek Budzinski (aged 38, arrested on [June 8, 1928](#) in [Zhytomyr, Ukraine](#); charged on [September 13, 1928](#) with 'distributing religious literature' i.e. prayer books; sentenced to

2 years' imprisonment on [February 11, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: sent to Kem, later transferred to Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp)

Russia: Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp

Fr Adolf Filipp (aged 44, arrested in [Vitebsk, Ukraine](#) on [January 10, 1927](#) on 'anti-Soviet agitation' charges; sentenced on [June 20, 1927](#) to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: transferred to Anzer Island as “a convict who was very resolute in the expression of his views”)
