Bishop Ignatius Sadkovskogo (aged 42, arrested on [January 17, 1923](#), interrogated; sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment on [August 24, 1923](#); **UPDATE**: arrested after meeting with priests to discuss Soviet harassment)

Saturday December 28, 1929



Russia: Leningrad

Archbishop Hilarion aka Vladimir Alexeyevich Troitsky (aged 44, arrested on [November 15, 1923](#); sentenced to a labor camp on [December 7, 1923](#), sent to [Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp](#); transferred to [Yaroslavl Prison](#) in [July 1925](#); transferred back to [Solovetsky](#) in [April 1926](#); **UPDATE**: [died of typhus](#) in a transfer prison, had been in transit to internal exile in Kazakhstan)

Fr Mieczyslaw Joudakas (aged 38, arrested in [December 1926](#), soon released; arrested in [April 1929](#), sent into 3 years' internal exile; **UPDATE**: released)

Fr Heronim Cerpento (aged 41, arrested, sentenced to 6 months' imprisonment)

Ukraine: Kiev

Antoni Garbowski (arrested, possibly convicted, fate unknown)

Fr Leonid Jurkiewicz (aged 50, arrested in [Brailov](#) on [May 26, 1929](#) despite being an invalid and suffering serious ailments; sentenced in [Kiev Prison](#) on [November 23, 1929](#) to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: sent to the Kotlas section of Temnikov camp)
