Ukraine: Zhytomyr

Fr Aleksander Kuczynski (aged 68, arrested in [Novohrad-Volynskiy, Ukraine](#), in 1923, sent into internal exile for 3 years; released from exile in 1925; arrested on [January 27, 1930](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 5 years' internal exile)

Ukraine: Kiev oblast

Antoni Dabrowski (aged 48, farmer, arrested on anti-Soviet charges in [Buda Makarivska, Kiev oblast](#) on [January 23, 1930](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sentence suspended, later released)

Fr Jozef Karpinski (aged 42, arrested on [October 26, 1929](#); indicted on [January 27, 1930](#) on anti-Soviet and counter-revolutionary charges; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp)

Fr Stanislaw Borecki (aged 39, arrested in [Belopole](#) on [January 15, 1930](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp)

Ukraine: Kiev

Fr Antoni Kurowski (aged 44, arrested in [Smotrycz](#) on [February 5, 1930](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp)

Fr Stanislaw Kasprzykowski (aged 47, arrested in [Chernivtsi](#) on [January 28, 1930](#), transferred to [Kiev Prison](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 7 years' imprisonment in a labor camp)

Fr Wladyslaw Dworzecki (aged 56, arrested on [January 26, 1930](#) in [Kamyanets-Podilsky](#), sent to Kiev, indicted on anti-Soviet and counter-revolutionary charges; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp)

Fr Jozef Bieniecki (aged 60, arrested in [Polonnoye, Shepetovsk, Kamianets-Podilskyi region](#) on [February 3, 1930](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp)

Ukraine: Kharkiv Prison

Fr Stanislaw Ganski (aged 50, brother of Stanislaw, arrested several times in Zhmerynka in 1922, finally sent to prison; released from prison on October 8, 1927; arrested on January 26, 1930; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 8 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Yaroslavl Prison)

Ukraine: Kiev

Fr Antoni Kobec (aged 50, brother of Fr Wojciech Kobec, arrested in Kupil on November 9, 1929; sentenced on May 10, 1930 to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: sent to the Yaroslavl Political Isolator in Russia)

Fr Wladyslaw Dworzecki (aged 56, arrested on January 26, 1930 in Kamyanets-Podilsky, sent to Kiev, indicted on anti-Soviet and counter-revolutionary charges; sentenced on May 12, 1930 to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp **UPDATE**: sent to solitary confinement in Yaroslavl prison, Russia)

Fr Jozef Bieniecki (aged 60, arrested in [Polonnoye, Shepetovsk, Kamianets-Podilskyi region](#) on [February 3, 1930](#); sentenced on [May 13, 1930](#) to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: transferred to solitary confinement in Yaroslavl Prison, Russia)

Fr Stanislaw Borecki (aged 39, arrested in [Belopole](#) on [January 15, 1930](#); sentenced on [May 12, 1930](#) to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: transferred to solitary confinement in Yaroslavl Prison, Russia)

Fr Stanislaw Kasprzykowski (aged 47, arrested in [Chernivtsi](#) on [January 28, 1930](#), transferred to [Kiev Prison](#); sentenced on [May 12, 1930](#) to 7 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: transferred to solitary confinement in Yaroslavl Prison, Russia)
