Fr Gabriel Vladimirov (aged 57, sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp)

Fr Stepan Eroian (aged 33, arrested on [November 26, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: convicted, sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a camp)

Russia: Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp

Fr Stepan Eroian (aged 33, arrested on [November 26, 1929](#) in [Tiflis, Georgia](#); convicted on [August 3, 1930](#), sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a camp; **UPDATE**: arrived, later transferred to Anzer Island)

Fr Ludwig Erk (aged 34, arrested in Slavhorod on [September 8, 1929](#); convicted on [March 23, 1930](#), sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a camp; **UPDATE**: arrived)

Andreas Engraf (arrested for aiding Fr Alois Kappes escape a manhunt, fate unknown)

Peter Gareis (aged 43, brother of Fr Adam Gareis, pharmacist, hid Fr Alois Kappes in his apartment and made him a false passport, arrested)
