Agata Bertneva (aged 45, pensioner, arrested on [October 9, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' internal exile, fate unknown)

Aniela Chmelnicka (aged 29, arrested on [October 9, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, fate unknown)

Anna Jakubowska (aged 51, arrested on [December 11, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' internal exile in Siberia, fate unknown)

Elena Gribul (aged 42, maid, arrested on [January 14, 1930](#); **UPDATE**: sent into internal exile, fate unknown)

Elizabeth Lipinska (aged 46, seamstress, arrested on [October 9, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' internal exile, fate unknown)

Franciszka Kokina (aged 42, factory worker, arrested on [January 15, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, fate unknown)

Fortunata Ladus-Chernyavskaya (aged 58, unemployed, arrested on [October 9, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sentence changed to 5 years' exile to Siberia, fate unknown)

Gabriella Emelian (aged 45, factory worker, arrested on [October 9, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to internal exile, fate unknown)

Ignati Bortkiewicz (aged 55, warehouse fireman, arrested on [October 29, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' internal exile, fate unknown)

Kazimira Kuszlejko (aged 58, unemployed, arrested on [October 9, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' internal exile, fate unknown)

Klementina Kalygina OSF (aged 42, milliner, arrested on [November 26, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, later sent into internal exile and then returned illegally to Leningrad to pursue active ministry)

Maria Gniedziewicz (aged 43, arrested on [December 12, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, fate unknown)

Petronelia Laimikas (aged 52, unskilled worker, arrested on [October 9, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' internal exile, fate unknown)

Stefania Ignatowicz (aged 51, arrested on [October 9, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, fate unknown)

Viktoria Balchunas (cook, arrested on [October 9, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' internal exile in the Northern Territory, fate unknown)

Viktoria Benionis (aged 57, pensioner, arrested on [January 14, 1930](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' internal exile in Siberia, fate unknown)

Viktoria Kissel (aged 42, pensioner, arrested on [October 9, 1929](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' internal exile, fate unknown)
