Russia: Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp

Fr Boleslaw Jurewicz (aged 43, arrested in [Leningrad](#) on [August 15, 1929](#); sentenced on [September 13, 1930](#) to 10 years' imprisonment in a concentration camp; **UPDATE:** arrived at camp, later transferred to Anzer Island)

Russia: Novorossijsk

Former monks arrested near [Rigza, Abkhazia, Georgia](#), on [April 24, 1930](#); **UPDATE: convicted of 'monarchist' charges**

Monday October 13, 1930



Ukraine: Kiev Prison

Fr Franciszek Czyski (aged 48, arrested in [Khmelnyskyi](#) on [January 16, 1930](#) on espionage and counter-revolutionary charges; at trial in [Kiev](#) said “God is my treasure. I cannot express the image of God in writing or in speech – thus I am a priest by conviction”, convicted on [June 30, 1930](#), sentenced to 7 years' imprisonment in a labor camp followed by 5 years' internal exile; **UPDATE:** transferred to the Yaroslavl Political Isolator)

Former monks arrested near [Rigza, Abkhazia, Georgia](#), on [April 24, 1930](#); convicted of 'monarchist' charges on [October 8, 1930](#); **UPDATE: executed**

Russia: Yaroslavl Prison

Fr Jozef Karpinski (aged 42, arrested in **Ukraine** on **October 26, 1929**; indicted on **January 27, 1930** on anti-Soviet and counter-revolutionary charges; sentenced on **May 12, 1930** to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; transferred to **Yaroslavl** on **May 26, 1930**;

UPDATE: transferred to Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp)
