Russia: Kirensk, Irkutsk oblast

Fr Bronislaw Dunin-Wasowicz (aged 33, sentenced in Ukraine on January 27, 1927 to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp after having been rearrested; released, sentenced to 3 years' internal exile in 1929; **UPDATE**: arrested)

Russia: Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp

Fr Kazimierz Krzywicki (aged 46, arrested in 1929 in Kopijowka, Ukraine on anti-Soviet agitation charges, sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment; **UPDATE**: transferred to Ukhtpechlag labor camp, wrote a letter to the Red Cross stating he was seriously ill and thought he would not survive a planned 400 mile march to the Ustukhta sub-camp)
