Fr Peter Sergeevich Petrikov (aged 28, arrested in Moscow on April 14, 1931 on anti-Soviet and counter-revolutionary charges; sentenced on June 5, 1931 to 3 years' imprisonment in a camp; **UPDATE**: released after appeal, sent into internal exile, settled in Murom)
