Russia: Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp

Michal Czekan (aged 49, parish council member, arrested on [October 9, 1929](#) on counter-revolutionary charges; sentenced on [September 13, 1930](#) to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE:** sentenced reduced to 8 years)

Russia: Mariinsky camp

Fr Petrikov Petr Sergeevich (aged 28, arrested in [Moscow](#) on [April 14, 1931](#) on anti-Soviet and counter-revolutionary charges; sentenced on [June 5, 1931](#) to 3 years' imprisonment in a camp; **UPDATE:** released after appeal, sent into internal exile, settled in Murom)
