Russia: Leningrad

Fr Iosif Dzemian (aged 43, arrested on [June 17, 1930](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in prison, sent to solitary confinement at Yaroslavl Prison in Russia)

Russia: Saratov

Fr Aleksey Anisimov (aged 57, bookkeeper, arrested on [April 14, 1931](#) and charged with anti-Soviet agitation; **UPDATE**: released for lack of evidence)

Russia: Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp

Fr Stanislaw Borecki (aged 40, arrested in [Belopole](#) on [January 15, 1930](#); sentenced on [May 12, 1930](#) to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: transferred to Kem)

Ukraine: Kamianets-Podilskyi

Fr Marian Jedruszak (aged 40, arrested on [November 26, 1931](#), charged with 'anti-Soviet agitation, illegal contacts with Poland and cooperation in contraband operations';

UPDATE: transferred to Kharkiv Prison)
