Monday February 1, 1932



Russia: Irkutsk

Fr Bronislaw Dunin-Wasowicz (aged 34, sentenced in [Ukraine](#) on [January 27, 1927](#) to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp after having been rearrested; released, sentenced to 3 years' internal exile in [Kirensk, Irkutsk oblast](#) in [1929](#); arrested in [March 1931](#); transferred in [June 1931](#) to solitary confinement in [Irkutsk](#); **UPDATE**: transferred to Krasnoyarsk Prison despite his sentence being completed)

Russia: Leningrad

Bishop Macarius aka Cosmas Vasilyevich Vasiliev (aged 61, arrested in [1924](#) for concealing church valuables, sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment, returned after 3 and a half years; **UPDATE**: arrested)

Russia: Leningrad

Ludwig Kokin (aged 47, church guard, arrested on anti-Soviet agitation and espionage charges on [November 16, 1931](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Sibltag)

Russia: Irkutsk

Fr Wiktor Krywencyk (aged 34, arrested in [Brusyliv, Ukraine](#) in [May 1926](#), sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to [Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp](#); sent into 3 years' internal exile to [Irkutsk](#) in [May 1929](#); arrested on [June 12, 1931](#); **UPDATE**: transferred to Krasnoyarsk Prison, housed with criminals)

Russia: Yaroslavl Prison

Fr Wladyslaw Dworzecki (aged 58, arrested on [January 26, 1930](#) in [Kamyanets-Podilsky](#), sent to Kiev, indicted on anti-Soviet and counter-revolutionary charges; sentenced on [May 12, 1930](#) to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent on [May 25, 1930](#) to solitary confinement in [Yaroslavl prison](#); **UPDATE**: transferred to Butyrka Prison hospital in Moscow)

Belarus: Minsk

Fr Michal Kucko-Kuczynski (aged 27, arrested on [March 29, 1926](#) on illegal border crossing charges; sentenced to 8 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on [January 11, 1927](#), held in [Minsk Prison](#); **UPDATE**: transferred to Butyrka Prison in Moscow)
