Russia: Moscow

Sr Lidia Gildebrandt OSF SVP (aged 43, widow, mother of a young daughter, arrested in [Petrograd](#) on [January 10, 1924](#); sentenced on [May 19, 1924](#) to 10 years' imprisonment; released from prison on [March 22, 1932](#) following a petition from the Red Cross, sentenced to internal exile; **UPDATE**: departed for Lipetsk, fate unknown)

Russia: Murom

Fr Petrikov Petr Sergeevich (aged 29, arrested in [Moscow](#) on [April 14, 1931](#) on anti-Soviet and counter-revolutionary charges; sentenced on [June 5, 1931](#) to 3 years' imprisonment in a camp; released from [Mariinsky camp](#) on [September 17, 1931](#) after appeal, sent into internal exile; **UPDATE**: arrested)
