Ippolit Balicki (aged 26, factory mechanic, arrested on [May 27, 1932](#); **UPDATE**: released for lack of evidence)

Russia: Ust-Vymskij correctional camp

Bishop Ignatius Sadkovskogo (aged 44, arrested in [Tula](#) on [December 26, 1929](#) after meeting with priests to discuss Soviet harassment; sentenced on [July 2, 1930](#) to 3 year's imprisonment; **UPDATE**: released, returned to Tula)

Russia: Moscow

Fr Dominik Ivanov-Stolbinsky (aged 49, arrested in [Leningrad](#) on [January 25, 1927](#), charged with 'organization of an illegal seminary, contacts with Jesuits abroad, hiding Polish spies in his apartment'; sentenced on [July 18, 1927](#) to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; sent to [Solovetsky](#) in [November 1928](#); sent to the [Onega region of Arkhangelsk oblast](#) in [June 1931](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, had been arrested in the spring)

Anastasia Gun (aged 48, homeowner, arrested in [Vyritsa](#) in [April 1932](#); **UPDATE:** sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, fate unknown)

Anelia Kolos OFS (aged 32, housekeeper, arrested in [April 1932](#); **UPDATE:** sentenced to 3 years' internal exile in Kazakhstan, fate unknown)

Anna Butkiewicz (aged 49, arrested in [April 1932](#); **UPDATE:** convicted, sentenced to 3 years' internal exile in Kazakhstan, fate unknown)

Anna Klopova (aged 35, business employee, arrested in [April 1932](#); **UPDATE:** sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, fate unknown)

Edward Blaziewicz (aged 58, stage prop manager, arrested in [April 1932](#); **UPDATE:** sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, fate unknown)

Elena Bmovas (aged 25, factory worker, arrested in [April 1932](#); **UPDATE:** sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp in Kazakhstan, fate unknown)

Sr Elizabeth Besekirskaya (aged 46, arrested in [April 1932](#); **UPDATE:** sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp in Kazakhstan, fate unknown)

Emilia Barkowska OFS (aged 61, arrested in [April 1932](#); **UPDATE:** sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp in Kazakhstan, fate unknown)

Kazimierz Balalaiko (aged 34, railroad packer, arrested in [April 1932](#); **UPDATE:** sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp in Kazakhstan, fate unknown)

Sr Magdalena Golubiewa (aged 54, arrested in [April 1932](#); **UPDATE:** sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, fate unknown)

Michalina Jarnicka (aged 54, nurse, arrested in [April 1932](#); **UPDATE:** sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp)

Pawel Browcin OPL (aged 58, construction center assistant, arrested; **UPDATE:** sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, fate unknown)

Robert Laus (aged 21, son of Ivan Laus, arrested in [April 1932](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, fate unknown)

Sofia Gordziewska (aged 54, housewife, assisted exiled clergy, arrested in [April 1932](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' exile in Kazakhstan, fate unknown)

Stanislaw Laus (aged 23, son of Ivan Laus, factory worker, arrested in [April 1932](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent into internal exile near Murmansk upon his release)

Teklia Buks OFS (age 47, hospital orderly, arrested in [April 1932](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' internal exile in Kazakhstan, fate unknown)

Sr Teklia Lazhevnik (aged 56, textile factory worker, arrested in [April 1932](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' internal exile to Kazakhstan, fate unknown)

Vasily Kubarev (aged 46, tailor, arrested in [April 1932](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, fate unknown)

Sofia Kliamko (aged 20, post office accountant, arrested in [April 1932](#); **UPDATE**: released for lack of evidence)
