Russia: Murom

Fr Petrikov Petr Sergeevich (aged 29, arrested in [May 1932](#); **UPDATE**: released due to lack of evidence)

Russia: Krasnoyarsk

Fr Wiktor Krywencyk (aged 34, arrested in Brusyliv, Ukraine in [May 1926](#), sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to [Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp](#); sent into 3 years' internal exile to [Irkutsk](#) in [May 1929](#); arrested on [June 12, 1931](#); transferred to [Krasnoyarsk Prison](#) in [February 1932](#), housed with criminals; **UPDATE**: transferred to Butyrka Prison in Moscow)

Russia: Mariinsk sector of Siblag labor camp

Fr Julian Gronski (aged 55, arrested in [Tomsk](#) on [April 25, 1931](#), later indicted on charges of “counter-revolutionary activity, espionage on behalf of Poland, hostile agitation, and hiding gold”; sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: transferred to Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp)

Ukraine: Kamianets-Podilskyi

Girzycki (arrested, possibly convicted, fate unknown)

Ukraine: Kiev

Richard Jasinski (aged 34, polisher, investigated for anti-Soviet activity in 1928, not convicted; again investigated in 1930 for anti-Soviet activity, not convicted; again investigated for anti-Soviet activity in 1931, not convicted; **UPDATE**: arrested on anti-Soviet charges)
