October 1932, date unknown



Russia: Moscow

Fr Michal Kucko-Kuczynski (aged 27, arrested in [Belarus](#) on [March 29, 1926](#) on illegal border crossing charges; sentenced to 8 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on [January 11, 1927](#), held in [Minsk Prison](#); transferred to [Butyrka Prison in Moscow](#) in [February 1932](#); **UPDATE**: sent into internal exile to Tolstovsky village outside Bryansk)

Russia: Yaroslavl Prison

Fr Johannes Deibner (aged 59, husband of Marie Panet Deibner, father of Fr Alexander Deibner and Ivan Deibner, arrested in [Petrograd](#) on [November 17, 1923](#); sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment on [May 19, 1924](#); **UPDATE**: released from prison, sent into internal exile to Vesegonsk, Tver oblast)
