Ukraine: Kharkiv Prison

Fr Marian Jedruszak (aged 41, arrested in [Kamianets-Podilskyi](#) on [November 26, 1931](#), charged with 'anti-Soviet agitation, illegal contacts with Poland and cooperation in contraband operations'; transferred to [Kharkiv Prison](#) in [December 1931](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Belbaltlag in Russia)

Russia: Yaroslavl

Fr Boleslaw Las (aged 27, U.S. citizen, arrested near [Vinnytsia in Ukraine](#) on [December 1, 1927](#) during an illegal border crossing, soon released; arrested on [February 15, 1929](#), sentenced to death; death sentence commuted in [1930](#) to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: transferred to Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp, had been in Yaroslavl Prison since the beginning of 1932)
