Russia: Siblag labor camp, Novosibirsk

Dmitry Kryuchkov (aged 45, literary translator, arrested in [Petrograd](#) on [December 7, 1923](#); sent to [Butyrka Prison in Moscow](#) on [December 19, 1923](#); sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment on [May 19, 1924](#), sent to [Irkutsk Prison](#); transferred to [Aleksandrov Political Isolator](#) in [June 1926](#), later transferred to [Siblag](#) and worked as a miner; **UPDATE:** released but sent into internal exile, later moved to Yaroslavl)

Russia: Northern Territory

Elena Befort (aged 34, teacher in [Saratov](#), resigned in [1918](#) rather than teach Marxism, became a city health department lab technician; arrested as a counter-revolutionary on [January 30, 1931](#); sentenced in [Saratov](#) on [June 6, 1931](#) to 3 years' internal exile; **UPDATE:** released)

Vladimir Balashev OPL (aged 52, engineer, arrested on [November 16, 1923](#); sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in May 1924; **UPDATE:** sent on internal exile in the Northern Territory for 3 years)
