Mikhail Ivasechko (aged 51, former miner, cabinetmaker, parish council chairman, arrested on [February 1, 1933](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' internal exile, sent to Arkhangelsk then Sevroput on the Northern Sea Route)

Russia: Ukhtpechlag labor camp, Chibiu, Komi ASSR

Fr Emmanuel Kaplonowski (aged 61, arrested in [Zwancyk, Ukraine](#) in [1922](#) on a charge of 'resisting the seizure of church valuables', soon released, arrested again in [1922](#) and released; arrested in [Stara Uszyca, Ukraine](#) in [March 1930](#); sentenced in [early 1931](#) to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: released, sentenced to internal exile in Siberia for 3 years)
