Karl Barth (aged 48, Swiss national, theologian, principal author of the Barmen Declaration, personally mailed a copy to Adolf Hitler after its adoption on [May 31, 1934](#); **UPDATE:** suspended from his university position after he refused to swear an oath of allegiance to Adolf Hitler)
