Fr Wladyslaw Kaminski (aged 72, arrested in [Blagoveshchensk](#) in 1924, released after a year's imprisonment; **UPDATE**: sent to Poland in a prisoner exchange)

### **Russia: Bamlag labor camp**

Sr Sophia Eismont OP (aged 35, arrested in [Ryazan](#) on [August 15, 1933](#), sent to [Moscow](#); sentenced on [February 19, 1934](#) to 8 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: arrested, sent to Ukhtpechlag)

Aleksandra Astrejko (aged 64, widow, unemployed, arrested)

Aleksandra Kachalova (aged 50, translator, arrested in [1931](#), released after two weeks; **UPDATE**: arrested)

Catherine Cicurina (aged 30, convert, state insurance typist, arrested)

Galina Jantkowska OPL (investigated for involvement in an illegal monastery, possibly convicted, fate unknown)

Nina Kenarskaya (aged 37, bookkeeper, arrested)

Tamara Barykova (aged 21, agricultural student, attended illegal Masses, arrested on [February 15, 1931](#), not convicted; **UPDATE**: arrested)

#### **Russia: Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp**

Fr Wladyslaw Dworzecki (aged 61, arrested on [January 26, 1930](#) in [Kamyanets-Podilsky](#), sent to Kiev, indicted on anti-Soviet and counter-revolutionary charges; sentenced on [May 12, 1930](#) to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: transferred to Belbaltlag labor camp)

#### **Russia: Bamlag labor camp, Amur region**

Vera Kruszelnicka (aged 20, niece of Camilla Kruszelnicka, investigated in [Moscow](#) in [1933](#) due to her friendship with the son of Marshal Voroshilov; sentenced on [February 19, 1934](#) to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: transferred to Ukhtpechlag)
