### Russia: Krasnoyarsk

Apollinaria Lisecka (aged 54, arrested on counter-revolutionary and espionage charges)

Fr Heronim Cerpento (aged 47, arrested on [October 16, 1931](#), soon released; **UPDATE**: arrested on espionage and counter-revolutionary charges)

Stanislaw Kosiarski (aged 56, farmer, sent into internal exile from [Leticzew, Khmelnytskyi district, Ukraine](#) in 1930; **UPDATE**: arrested)

### Germany: Bonn

Karl Barth (aged 48, Swiss national, theologian, principal author of the Barmen Declaration, personally mailed a copy to Adolf Hitler after its adoption on [May 31, 1934](#); suspended from his university position on [November 26, 1934](#) after he refused to swear an oath of

allegiance to Adolf Hitler; **UPDATE:** forcibly retired from the university, left for Switzerland, when later asked if he supported the Swiss Army replied “Yes, especially along the northern border!”)
