Monday March 16, 1936



Russia: Moscow

Bishop Ignatius Sadkovskogo (aged 48, arrested in Tula on February 3, 1936 on counter-revolutionary charges, sent to Moscow; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 5 years' internal exile, sent to Arkhangelsk)

Russia: Ashaga-Dzhamin, Taurida province, Crimea

Eduard Feist (aged 29, collective farm cashier, home raided, liturgical items used in clandestine Masses found)

Russia: Dzhaychi, Taurida province, Crimea

Ivan Gegelman (aged 45, collective farm bookkeeper and cabinet maker, arrested, found with a cross in his home, charged as the “organizer of listening to German fascist propaganda on the collective farm radio in Dzhaychi; subscribed to the German newspaper Kolnische Zeitung and distributed it among the collective farm workers”)

Eduard Feist (aged 29, collective farm cashier, home raided on [March 28, 1936](#), liturgical items used in clandestine Masses found; **UPDATE**: arrested)

Russia: Crimea

Antoni Gaszek (aged 37, farmer, arrested on [January 13, 1934](#) on nationalistic and slander charges; sentenced on [March 22, 1934](#) to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, later acquitted and released; **UPDATE**: arrested)

Joseph Gauck (aged 63, parish council member, arrested)

Phillip Kolsch (aged 28, arrested)

Anton Josifovich Godzelikh (aged 49, church guard, arrested)

Josif Antonovich Godzelikh (aged 54, electrician, arrested)

Stanislaw Dabrowski (aged 47, arrested on [August 20, 1935](#) in [Bazalia, Vinnytsia oblast](#) on counter-revolutionary charges; sentenced on [January 12, 1936](#) to 4 years' imprisonment in a labor camp followed by 2 years' loss of rights; **UPDATE**: sentence upheld on appeal, fate unknown)

Fr Bronislaw Dunin-Wasowicz (aged 38, arrested on espionage charges in [May 1935](#), sent to [Krasnoyarsk Prison](#), released 10 months later; **UPDATE**: arrested for allegedly supporting the Polish Military Organization, transferred to Novosibirsk Prison)

Fr Heronim Cerpento (aged 48, arrested on [June 2, 1935](#) on espionage and counter-revolutionary charges; **UPDATE**: transferred to Novosibirsk Prison)

Russia: Sushtan-Bazar, Taurida region, Crimea

Joseph Benz (arrested, fate unknown)

Russia: Yevpatoria, Crimea

Martin Haag (aged 51, arrested for having 'close contact with the German pastor Frison')
