Sunday May 8, 1938



Russia

Stanislaw Bach (aged 38, bookkeeper, church organist, arrested on **April 25, 1931** in **Belostok, Tomsk oblast**, later sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; released in **1934**, sent on internal exile; arrested on **February 9, 1938** in **Tatyanovka, Shegersk, Tomsk region**, later sentenced to death; **UPDATE: shot dead**)

Kazakhstan

Catherine Galler (aged 62, widow, arrested in **Kiev, Ukraine** on **July 29, 1935** for donating money to persecuted Christians and keeping religious literature in her home; sentenced to 3 years' internal exile on **May 14, 1936**; **UPDATE: sentence extended another 3 years for 'anti-Soviet agitation'**)

Russia: Magadan Prison

Magdalena Frison (aged 41, niece of Bishop Alexander Frison, worked as his housekeeper and courier to Moscow, arrested in [Simferopol](#) on [October 26, 1935](#) on counter-revolutionary charges; sentenced on [March 17, 1937](#) to 8 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; arrested in [Sevvostoklag labor camp](#) on [April 7, 1938](#) on counter-revolutionary charges; **UPDATE:** sentenced to death)

Magdalena Frison (aged 41, niece of Bishop Alexander Frison, worked as his housekeeper and courier to Moscow, arrested in [Simferopol](#) on [October 26, 1935](#) on counter-revolutionary charges; sentenced on [March 17, 1937](#) to 8 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; arrested in [Sevvostoklag labor camp](#) on [April 7, 1938](#) on counter-revolutionary charges; sentenced to death on [May 11, 1938](#); **UPDATE: shot dead**)
