Stanislaw Bach (aged 38, bookkeeper, church organist, arrested on April 25, 1931 in Belostok, Tomsk oblast, later sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; released in 1934, sent on internal exile; arrested on February 9, 1938 in Tatyanovka, Shegersk, Tomsk region, later sentenced to death; **UPDATE**: shot dead)

Catherine Galler (aged 62, widow, arrested in Kiev, Ukraine on July 29, 1935 for donating money to persecuted Christians and keeping religious literature in her home; sentenced to 3 years' internal exile on May 14, 1936; **UPDATE**: sentence extended another 3 years for 'anti-Soviet agitation')

Magdalena Frison (aged 41, niece of Bishop Alexander Frison, worked as his housekeeper and courier to Moscow, arrested in Simferopol on October 26, 1935 on counter-revolutionary charges; sentenced on March 17, 1937 to 8 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; arrested in Sevvostoklag labor camp on April 7, 1938 on counter-revolutionary charges;

UPDATE: sentenced to death)
