Germany: Dachau concentration camp

Fr Konrad Just OC (aged 36; fed once only every fourth day, ate soap; **UPDATE**: released from the starvation diet)

Germany: Sachsenhausen concentration camp

Pastor Werner Koch (former student of Dietrich Bonhoeffer, arrested by the Gestapo on [November 13, 1936](#) for allegedly sending an anti-Nazi homily of the Confessing Church to foreign news media; transferred to Sachsenhausen concentration camp on [February 13, 1936](#); **UPDATE**: released)

Fr Matthias Spanlang (aged 61, Austrian, arrested on [May 24, 1938](#) for anti-Nazi homilies and newspaper articles; **UPDATE:** refused to accept a conditional release, later transferred to Buchenwald)
