Fr Pawel Chomicz (aged 45, arrested in [Leningrad](#) on [December 3, 1926](#), charged with counter-revolutionary activities; released from camp on [November 10, 1936](#), sent into internal exile to [Kostroma](#); **UPDATE**: returned to Leningrad and lived underground, performed a large number of pastoral duties)
