Fr Stanislaw Kubista SVD (aged 41, Polish citizen, taken to Sachsenhausen, beaten and starved)

Germany: Stutthof concentration camp

Fr Stanislaus Adameczyk (aged 56, Polish citizen, arrested in [Koneck, Poland](#) on [October 21, 1939](#), sent to Gorna Grupa transit camp and then to Stutthof; **UPDATE**: transferred to Sachsenhausen concentration camp)

Fr Jozef Wojciech Guz (aged 50, arrested by the Soviets in [Grodno](#) on [March 21, 1940](#), later escaped, crossed into German occupied Poland and was arrested; **UPDATE: imprisoned**)

Tuesday April 23, 1940



Germany: Sachsenhausen concentration camp

Fr Stanislaus Adamczyk (aged 56, Polish citizen, arrested in [Koneck, Poland](#) on [October 21, 1939](#), sent to Gorna Grupa transit camp and then to Stutthof concentration camp; transferred to Sachsenhausen on [April 9, 1940](#); **UPDATE: died of pneumonia**)

Fr Tadeusz Fedorowicz (aged 33, volunteered to join a group of Poles who were being deported for work in Siberia, identified as a priest and arrested, sent to Karlag labor camp, Kazakhstan)

Poland - now Ukraine: Zolochiv

Fr Leopold Dallinger (aged 56, arrested by the Soviets, transported to Semipalatinsk oblast, Kazakhstan)
