## Saturday October 21, 1940



### Russia: Arkhangelsk Promkombinat camp, Bereznyaki

Fr Boleslaw Dzudziewicz (aged 32, arrested by the Soviets in Drahichyn on January 11, 1940; sentenced as a "socially dangerous element" to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on August 6, 1940; UPDATE: escaped from the camp, recaptured, sentence increased to 10 years', sent to Ust-vymlag, Komi ASSR)

Sofia Bratkowska ACJ (arrested July 10, 1940, had hidden Fr Pawel Welij in her home from February through July 1940; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 5 years' internal exile)
