Germany: Munich

Lieselotte 'Lilo' Ramdohr (aged 29, widow, White Rose resistance member, arrested, released for lack of evidence, arrest and execution ordered by Heinrich Himmler later in the month, escaped, went into hiding, married, survived the war)

Archbishop Johann Konrad Maria Augustin Felix, Graf von Preysing Lichtenegg-Moos (aged 62, **UPDATE**: wrote to Pope Pius XII "There is probably no bitterer trial for us here in Berlin than the new wave of Jewish deportations")

Leopold Engleitner (aged 37, conscientious objector, arrested [April 4, 1939](#); **UPDATE**: transferred to Niederhagen concentration camp)

Fr Julien-Sylvain Bousquet MEP (aged 66, French citizen, arrested on [February 17, 1943](#);

UPDATE: **died** in a hospital for the insane)

Metropolitan Kiril aka Konstantin Markov (aged 42, joined Jews who had been arrested for deportation to Germany and told them “I will not allow any of you to leave Plovdiv”, told King Boris that he would start a civil disobedience campaign and that he would personally lie down on the railroad tracks in front of the deportation trains, the order was rescinded)

Fifty missionaries of several denominations - mostly Germans - and 12 other civilians were killed aboard the Imperial Japanese Navy destroyer Akikaze

France: Rennes

Marcel Callo (aged 21, printer, fiancé of Marguerite Derniaux, conscripted into forced labor, told by Marguerite that he would die a martyr, replied “I could never deserve such an honor” , sent to Zella-Mehlis, Thuringia, Germany)

Saturday March 20, 1943



Turkmenistan

Fr Franciszek Janocha OFM (aged 31, arrested in [Lviv](#) by the Soviets in [July 1940](#), sentenced to death, commuted to imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to [Unzhlag](#); amnestied as a Polish citizen on [September 2, 1941](#); appointed chaplain of the Polish Armed Forces of the East on [March 1, 1942](#) in [Chok-Pak, Kazakhstan](#); **UPDATE**: arrested on anti-Soviet and espionage charges)

Tuesday March 23, 1943



Greece: Athens

Archbishop Damaskinos Papandreou (aged 52, issued a letter to the collaborationist Prime Minister which protested the arrest and deportation of Jews: “The Greek people were rightfully surprised and deeply grieved to learn that the German Occupation Authorities

have already started to put into effect a program of gradual deportation of the Greek Jewish community of Salonika to places beyond our national borders, and that the first groups of deportees are already on their way to Poland....In our national consciousness, all the children of Mother Greece are an inseparable unity: they are equal members of the national body irrespective of religion or dogmatic difference...Our Holy Religion does not recognize superior or inferior qualities based on race or religion, as it is stated: 'There is neither Jew nor Greek' and thus condemns any attempt to discriminate or create racial or religious differences. Our common fate, both in days of glory and in periods of national misfortune, forged inseparable bonds between all Greek citizens, without exemption, irrespective of race...", when threatened with death by firing squad in retaliation by SS General Jurgen Stroop he replied "According to the traditions of the Greek Orthodox Church, our prelates are hanged, not shot. Please respect our traditions!" [a reference to the 1821 lynching of his predecessor Gregory V by a Turkish mob], ordered all clergy to aid the hiding of Jews)

Austria: Vienna

Sr Helena Kafka (aged 48, arrested on [February 18, 1942](#) for hanging crucifixes in a new hospital wing in [Vienna](#) in defiance of the Nazis; convicted of treason and sentenced to death on [October 29, 1942](#); **UPDATE**: **guillotined** after refusing to leave her religious order)

Bulgaria: Sofia

Metropolitan Stefan aka Stoyan Poppueorguiev (survived the [April 16, 1925](#) communist bombing of St Nedelya Church, which killed 150 and injured 500; **UPDATE:** successfully confronted King Boris concerning the pending deportation of 8,000 Jews to Germany, threatened to open churches and monasteries to shelter Jews if the order was not rescinded)

Poland: Auschwitz Concentration Camp

Sr Maria Cecilia Autsch OSST.Ter (aged 43, Austrian national, arrested in [Motz, Austria](#) on [August 12, 1940](#) after saying Hitler was a calamity for Europe; transferred to [Ravensbruck concentration camp, Germany](#) on [August 31, 1940](#), became known for her support of other prisoners despite frequent beatings; arrived at [Auschwitz](#) on [March 26, 1942](#); **UPDATE:** transferred to the Birkenau extermination sub-camp)
