Wednesday September 1, 1943



Germany: Dusseldorf

Fr Roger Derry (aged 42, French citizen, arrested in Paris on [October 9, 1941](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to death)

Germany begins military operations within and against Italy



Turkmenistan

Fr Franciszek Janocha OFM (aged 31, arrested in [Lviv](#) by the Soviets in [July 1940](#), sentenced to death, commuted to imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to [Unzhlag](#); amnestied as a Polish citizen on [September 2, 1941](#); appointed chaplain of the Polish Armed Forces of the East on [March 1, 1942](#) in [Chok-Pak, Kazakhstan](#); arrested on [March 20, 1943](#) on anti-Soviet and espionage charges; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 8 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Ukhtizhmlag)

Vatican City

Pope Pius XII aka Eugenio Maria Giuseppe Giovanni Pacelli (aged 67, **UPDATE**: told his closest aides that his arrest by the Germans could be imminent, had said "If they want to arrest me they will have to drag me from the Vatican...the person who would leave under

these conditions would not be Pius XII but Eugenio Pacelli", thus indicating his resignation as Pope would take effect at that moment)

Thursday September 9, 1943



Germany: Plotzensee prison, Berlin

Theodor Hespers (aged 39, fled Germany in [April 1933](#) to publish anti-Nazi Christian literature in the Netherlands, became a Dutch citizen; arrested by the Gestapo in [Antwerp](#) on [February 10, 1942](#), tortured; sentenced to death on [July 22, 1943](#); **UPDATE: hanged**)

Fr Giuseppe Bernardi (aged 45, **killed**)

Fr Mario Ghibauda (aged 23, **killed**)

Italy - now Croatia: Rovinj, Istarska

Fr Angelo Tarticchio (aged 36, arrested by Yugoslav partisans, tortured; **UPDATE**: mutilated and **killed**, later found to have been buried with a crown of thorns embedded in his head)

Salvo D'Acquisto (aged 22, military police sergeant, **shot dead** after saving 22 hostages by claiming that he alone was responsible for an accidental explosion in which one German SS soldier was killed)
