### Russia: Moscow

Archimandrite Fabian Abrantowicz, MIC (aged 61, detained by Soviet border guards on [October 22, 1939](#); tortured in [Lviv](#) prison, indicted for espionage on [November 13, 1939](#); charged with "fighting against the revolutionary movement and making an illegal border crossing" on [August 15, 1942](#); sentenced to ten years' imprisonment in a labor camp on [September 23, 1942](#); **UPDATE**: [died possibly from torture](#) in Butyrka Prison)

Fr Wladyslaw Kernicki OFM (aged 34, arrested in [Lviv, Ukraine](#) in [July 1944](#), sentenced to possibly 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: transferred to NKVD GuShosDor Camp No 1, worked in road construction, later escaped)
