Croatia

Trial begun of six nuns accused of treating Ustashi patients in their hospital ahead of Communist partisan patients

Sr Celesti Lucia Radosevic (sentenced to death by firing squad, later commuted to 20 years' imprisonment at hard labor)

Sr Eutihia Novak (sentenced to death by firing squad, later commuted to 20 years' imprisonment at hard labor)

Sr Hubertina Dzimbeg (sentenced to death by firing squad, later commuted to 20 years' imprisonment at hard labor)

Sr Julijana Ivasic (aged 37, sentenced to death by hanging)

Sr Verena Fostac (sentenced to death by firing squad, later commuted to 20 years' imprisonment at hard labor)

Russia: Vorkutlag labor camp

Fr Antoni Chomicki (aged 36, arrested in [Klesov, Ukraine](#) on counter-revolutionary charges on [February 16, 1945](#), convicted, sentenced in [Rivine prison, Ukraine](#) to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on [February 6, 1946](#); **UPDATE**: arrived)

Fr Giovanni Fausti SJ (aged 47, Italian citizen, arrested on war crimes and espionage charges on [December 31, 1945](#), tortured; **UPDATE**: sentenced to death)

Fr Kole Shllaku OFM (aged 39, sentenced to death)
