Tuesday May 13, 1947



Ukraine: Kamyanets-Podilsky

Fr Wladyslaw Dworzecki (aged 73, arrested on [January 26, 1930](#) in [Kamyanets-Podilsky](#), sent to Kiev, indicted on anti-Soviet and counter-revolutionary charges; sentenced on [May 12, 1930](#) to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; granted early release from [Belbaltlag labor camp, Russia](#) on [April 16, 1936](#) as an invalid, returned to Kamyanets-Podilsky; **UPDATE:** home raided by NKVD agents with an arrest order, order not executed because “the priest is paralyzed and not able to stand”, continued to hear confessions until his **death** later that year)

Poland: Warsaw

Cardinal August Hlond (aged 65, fled [Poland](#) on [September 18, 1939](#) at the request of the government, reported to the Vatican on the extent of German atrocities; arrested by the Gestapo in [Hautecombe, Savoy, France](#) in [February 1944](#), taken to Paris and then Wiedenbrück in Germany, freed at the end of the war and returned to Poland; **UPDATE:** wrote a pastoral letter regarding communist actions "Since the days of St. Peter, the Church has not been subjected to a persecution such as that to which she is subjected today")
