PCOCP

Russia: Tavdinlag labor camp, Tavda, Sverdlovsk region

Fr Aleksander Korniliak (aged 50, arrested by the Soviets in [Siedlce, Poland](#) on [November 10, 1944](#), sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: released, returned to Poland)

Russia: Usollag labor camp, Solikamsk, Perm region

Fr Michal Drabik (aged 35, arrested in [Sambor, Ukraine](#) on [January 12, 1945](#); sentenced on [July 17, 1947](#) in [Drohobych, Ukraine](#) to 8 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: transferred to Vorkutlag labor camp)

India: Baramulla, Jammu and Kashmir

Sr Joaquina de Zubiri Ssnchez FMM (aged 29, Spanish citizen, **shot three times** by local tribesmen when she stepped in front of her mother superior to protect her, five other staff and patients were also killed, a further massacre was then adverted by the arrival of the Pakistani military, **died ten hours later**)
