Monday November 8, 1948



Bulgaria: Kolarovo, Petrich district

Metropolitan Vangel Simov Razumov (aged 50, **shot dead** by an assassin in front of 1,000 worshipers during the Divine Liturgy, last words were “Don’t! You are committing a great sin!”)

Fr Waclaw Jaziewicz (aged 40, arrested in [Nesvizh](#) on [August 2, 1948](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 25 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Ozerlag in Russia)

Belarus: Minsk

Fr Stanislaw Lazar (aged 43, arrested on [July 20, 1948](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, later sent to Minlag in Russia)

Russia: Kaluga

Sr Raisa Krylevskaya OP (aged 52, arrested in [Kostroma](#) on [October 9, 1933](#); another prisoner testified on [November 16, 1933](#) “Raisa Ivanovna Krylevskaya was endlessly devoted to Mother Catherine Abrikosova and Bishop [Eugene] Neveu. In her words, she would follow them 'to the firing squad'”; under interrogation in [Moscow](#) on [December 6, 1933](#) said “I have expressed counter-revolutionary views, directed against the policies of the Party and Soviet authority. I stand by my counter-revolutionary views even now. I have not changed them and do not choose to do so. I am a fundamental opponent of the policy being carried out by Soviet power both in the city and in the countryside”; sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on [February 19, 1934](#); released from a labor camp in the [Komi ASSR](#) in [October 1943](#), sent into internal exile to [Kazakhstan](#); released from internal exile in the [spring of 1947](#); **UPDATE**: arrested on espionage charges)

Sr Sophia Eismont OP (aged 48, arrested in [Ryazan](#) on [August 15, 1933](#), sent to [Moscow](#); sentenced on [February 19, 1934](#) to 8 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to [Bamlag](#); arrested on [February 2, 1935](#), sent to [Ukhtpechlag](#); transferred to [Vorkutlag](#) in [1938](#); released on [June 23, 1942](#); **UPDATE**: arrested)
