Fr Andrzej Gladysiewicz (aged 35, arrested in [Volodymyr-Volynskyi, Ukraine](#) on [January 4, 1945](#); sentenced on [March 28, 1945](#) to 7 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE:** sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp for hearing confessions, transferred to Norillag)
