Kazakhstan: Steplag labor camp

Fr Wladyslaw Kisel (aged 56, arrested in [Vilnius, Lithuania](#) on [December 1, 1944](#); sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on [August 22, 1945](#), sent to [Karlak](#) and later to Steplag; **UPDATE**: **died**)
